









INFORMATION FOR VISITORS

DURING AN OUTBREAK OF VIRAL GASTROENTERITIS

Some residents in this Care Home are affected with diarrhoea and vomiting which may be due to a virus. The care home will make available a general leaflet about viral gastroenteritis. In order to reduce the risk of infection passing to others we would be grateful if you would observe the following:

Please

-  Do not visit if you have had diarrhoea or vomiting unless you have been well for the last 48 hours
-  Do not visit if you feel unwell
-  Do not go from resident to resident
 - stay with the person you are visiting
-  Do not bring babies or young children with you
-  Avoid hand to mouth contact while you are visiting
-  Do let us know if you become unwell after visiting the home
-  Do ask a member of staff for assistance if your relative or friend needs help with the toilet
-  **Do remember to wash your hands thoroughly, using soap and water**
 - **before visiting and before leaving the home.**
