## Question Set: Central Venous Catheter [CVC] Insertion - Insertion

1	Is surgical hand preparation performed before the procedure? (20, 90)	Observe practice. Moment 2 - before an aseptic task.				
2	Is a sterile gown worn during the procedure?	Observe practice.				
3	Are sterile gloves worn during the procedure?	Observe practice.				
4	Is a mask worn during insertion of the CVC procedure?	Observe practice.				
5	Is a single use paper hat worn during the procedure?	Observe practice.				
6	Is the CVC which is used single lumen unless otherwise clinically indicated?	Observe practice and check documentation.				
7	Is the procedure trolley cleaned prior to use?	Observe practice.				
8	Is the CVC insertion site either subclavian or jugular (unless another site is clinically indicated)?	Check documentation gives rationale for choosing alternative site.				
9	Is Chlorhexidine 2% in 70% alcohol applied to the insertion site and allowed to dry before insertion?	Observe practice, where there is sensitivity check povidone lodine is used.				
10	Are disposable sterile drapes used?	Observe a procedure.				
11	Is asepsis maintained throughout the procedure?	Check: Sterile Items are intact. Sterile Packs integrity. Equipment is in date. No unsterile items are touched. Contaminated items are replaced.				
12	Is blood removed from the skin around the insertion site using Chlorhexidine 2% in alcohol?	Observe practice.				
13	Is a sterile, semi permeable, transparent dressing placed over the insertion site?	Observe practice or ask a member of staff to describe procedure.				
14	Is date, time, site and insertion documented and signed by the person inserting the device?	Check documentation.

Is hand hygiene performed immediately following removal of personal protective equipment?	Observe practice. Moment 3 - after body fluid exposure.
